Staffing for 2020-2021

- Mrs Szuch (4<sup>th</sup> grade) is leaving
- Ms Nickel (school psychologist) is leaving
- Mrs Tedrick (para) is retiring

This year Fir Grove had 16 classrooms. Based on enrollment projections and budget, next year Fir Grove will have 15 classrooms. That's if the Student Investment Account money (from Student Success Act) comes through.

Fir Grove has received 2 refrigerators and a microwave for the staff room. These items were donated by IBM.

PTO is paying for a dishwasher for the staff room – hoping to have it installed before school starts in the fall.

Grab and go meals will be served at Fir Grove Monday-Thursday all summer long.

Camp Achieve, the online summer school, has over 40 Fir Grove students so far. \$10 for the whole summer!

Still working on what the contract with Shadow Project will look like since things were interrupted this year.

## **Budget Update: Kristina Hiersche**

May budget

- Income of almost \$500. That's from box tops, volunteer hour matches, and Amazon Smile.
- Expenses of about \$2400
  - o 5<sup>th</sup> grade sendoff \$550 for tshirts. In June expenses for 5<sup>th</sup> grade gift cards and candy will hit.
  - o Art Lit
  - o Field day
  - Tech cleaning wipes for keyboards
  - o Teacher supplies
  - Wellness center (now SELC)
- Almost \$14,000 cash remaining. A lot of that will roll forward.

2020-2021 PTO budget – built assuming business as usual in the fall. In August/early September when we know staff numbers and whether school will be in person or remote, we can revise. See notes on budget document in far right column. Total income just over \$40,000, total expenses just under \$55,000. Our plan is to have a virtual fun run if we can't do it in person.
