- We are working on getting access to the water source so the community can come and water whenever this summer.

Raleigh Hills Rebuild/Community School vs Mega School Discussion - Sarah Hinton

- Sarah, along with Kate Prakash and Emily Wolverton, encouraged the Fir Grove community to watch the Raleigh Hills Rebuild process closely, as the district seems to be moving away from smaller community schools and toward larger mega schools that accommodate closer to 750 students.
- While the district put the consolidation plan on hold for the summer, we should watch the
 process closely, as Fir Grove was in some of the district's proposed scenarios to close
 and consolidate with Hiteon Elementary school.
- It seems that while this is not in the immediate future, it seems we have seen behind the curtain of the district's facilities planning the Raleigh Hills consolidation as phase 1, and the future of Fir Grove as phase 2.
- The reality is Fir Grove's enrollment is projected to continue to decline and the building is in one of the worst shape in the entire district.
- Continue to let our voice be heard on the district level through School Board Meeting comments, etc. - that we hope that the Fir Grove community can be involved in the future of our school when the time comes.
